Daniel F. Johnson, 1953-2005

The Database of Vital Statistics from New Brunswick Newspapers, based on over twenty-three years of work by Danny Johnson, is an extraordinary contribution to genealogical, biographical, demographic and historical research. The Provincial Archives of New Brunswick is honoured to present it on their web site as a tribute to Danny and a resource for researchers.

About the compiler

Daniel Fred Johnson was born on August 25, 1953 in Fort Fairfield, Maine, the youngest child of Fay (Tregunno) and Verdell C. Johnson. He grew up in Perth-Andover and graduated from Southern Victoria High School in 1971. He obtained a Bachelor of Business Administration from the University of New Brunswick in 1975 and settled into employment in the commercial and insurance fields.

Danny's early attentiveness to family stories and his own love of telling stories presaged his later passion for history and genealogy. His first employment in the field was as manager of a project sponsored by the Victoria County Historical Society collecting stories of the county for their annual publication, the Tobique. He stayed with the project long past its formal termination and between 1979 and 1990 edited the stories and saw to their publication. The undertaking fostered his interest in history, genealogy and publishing.

Danny's work on his own family history and the knowledge and skills he gained as he did his research led to a broader involvement in genealogy and he began to assist with the searches of others. He taught one of the first organized courses in genealogy in Saint John in 1979. Along with a number

In 1832, a provincial statute (2 William IV Chapter 36) was enacted by the General Assembly of New Brunswick, "An Act to Impose a Duty on Emigrants" (see link above). It imposed a duty of five shillings for each passenger landed which was to be collected from the funds collected were to be directed towards the relief from the burdens of caring for diseased and disabled emigrants. The records of Custom House records retained in the Province. In 1835, the provincial Secretary was given responsibility for the records.

Some manifests include details on the passenger, such as age, occupation, sex, county or point of origin, and the number of passengers on board and the duty due. (These could not be indexed and were not digitized.)

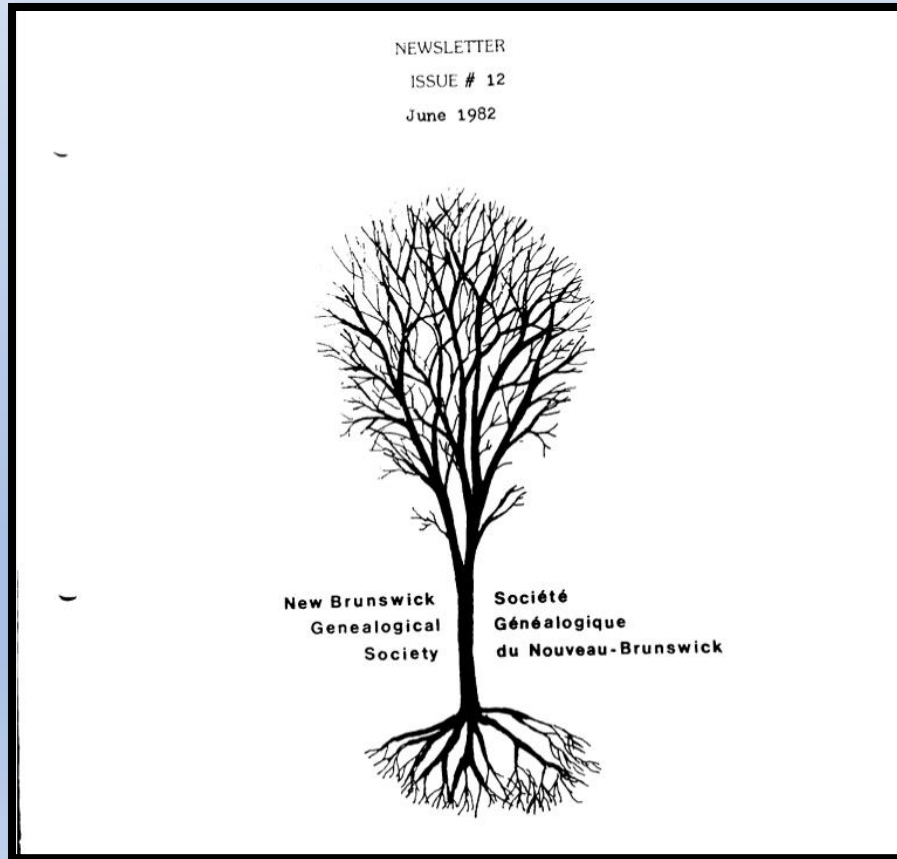

NB Cemetery Records Project

This project aims to ensure that vital historical and operational records for cemeteries in NB are properly archived and accessible for future generations.

Introduction: The New Brunswick Genealogical Society (NBGS), the Provincial Archives of New Brunswick (PANB) and the Association of New Brunswick Cemeteries (ANBC) partnered in 2025 to conduct a province-wide survey of records held at cemeteries to determine their location, condition, and archival value. PANB is offering archival storage and professional preservation for at risk records.

This collection is an index of the types of records that exist for cemeteries in NB and where they are stored. It is not a listing of names and burial locations.

The archival collections of the New Brunswick Museum consist of business records, personal papers and ephemera relating to the economic, social, legal, military, religious and political aspects of life in New Brunswick, with a nineteenth century emphasis. The historical documents contained in these collections reflect the time in which they were written, but by current standards, some terminology and phrasing may offend contemporary sensibilities. In order to retain the integrity of the documents, no attempt has been made to make changes in wording.



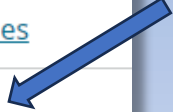

What are some of the **limitations to research in New Brunswick?**

Fire, fire and fire. And of course, floods, hurricanes and other extreme weather events. Improper storage methods, vandalism and a general disregard for keeping historic records would also be major factors. Some major fires took out records, as did smaller fires in churches and government offices.

First of all, the **Provincial Archives** did not open until 1967, and much material was lost before that time. With nowhere to deposit old records they were often discarded.

Government Vital Statistics records were not required by law until 1888 and the law was not enforced until 1920.

Other factors that make it difficult or impossible to find records in New Brunswick include the fact that **early marriage records** did not normally include the names of parents, or the ages of the bride and groom. **Early death records** did not list spouses, parents or informants. Many church records have not survived.
