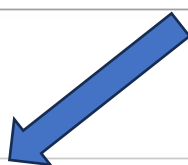
### Search Tips

- Use spaces to require multiple words anywhere in the record (e.g. *mary 1848*).
- Click **Search** to find matching records across both sheet formats.
- Click a result to open the full detail card. Use **Print** to print just the card.
- Autocomplete: Select a suggested word by mouse or arrow+enter.

### NB Cemetery Records Project

This project aims to ensure that vital historical and operational records for cemeteries in NB are properly archived and accessible for future generations.

**Introduction:** The New Brunswick Genealogical Society (NBGS), the Provincial Archives of New Brunswick (PANB) and the Association of New Brunswick Cemeteries (ANBC) partnered in 2025 to conduct a province-wide survey of records held at cemeteries to determine their location, condition, and archival value. PANB is offering archival storage and professional preservation for at risk records.

This collection is an index of the types of records that exist for cemeteries in NB and where they are stored. It is not a listing of names and burial locations.

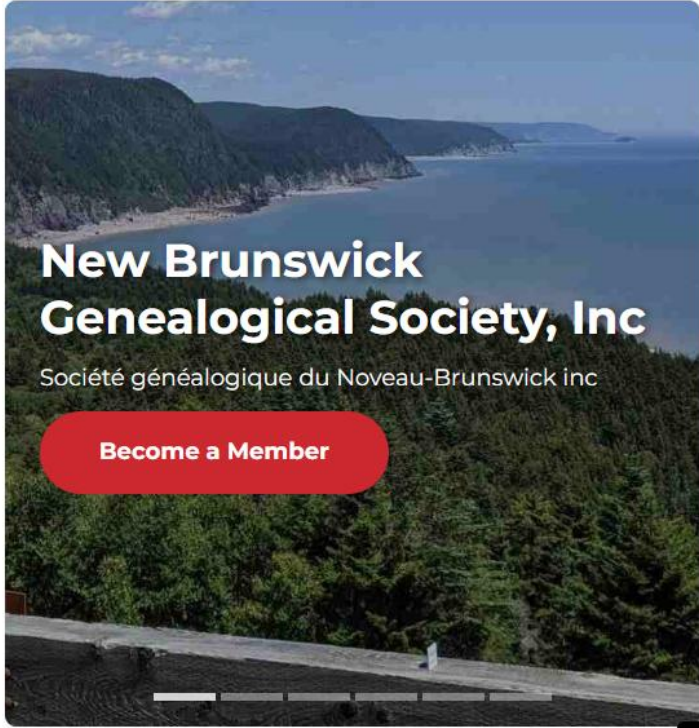
